What is BALOO training?

BALOO stands for Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation. It's designed to introduce Cub Scout leaders to the newly expanded opportunities for pack overnight camping. This is an energetic training that will cover everything you need to know to plan and run a pack overnighter. It's more than just camping—it includes ideas for outdoor activities, games and ceremonies; information on selecting and using camping equipment; how to run a campfire program; and hands-on Cub Scout cooking demonstrations! In short, everything you need to know to make your pack overnighter a fun, successful event!

Why do I need to take BALOO training?

BSA has made a number of changes to the camping policy for Tigers, Cub Scouts and Webelos. Adults leading a pack overnighter **MUST** attend BALOO training in order to be issued a tour permit.
